2024-03-22 John and Graham speak with US Senator Ron Johnson...

Hi, everybody. It's 11 PM when Wednesday, the 20th of March here in Australia. And joining us tonight, John, we have one of the champions of the battles that we've been fighting in the last few years around the world. Republican Senator from Wisconsin, Senator Ron Johnson. It's great to have you with us, Senator.

Oh, good morning, gentlemen. Hope you're doing well. Or as good evening for you. Yes, it is. And yeah, we're doing well, because we've got you on and it's it's great to have you aboard. We were addressing our own Senate here in Australia last Wednesday. And we had an opportunity to tell it like it is. And what we noticed was that we had a pretty good hearing.

And one of the issues that I raised as a former instructor in Human Factors in the airline industry, um, was that in critical, in crisis situations, critical thinking demands that we look at all the options. So we, if we use the Apollo 13 mission as an example, how a whole bunch of people got together in Houston.

They threw everything they had that they knew was in the, in the capsule that could be used to bring those astronauts home. And pretty much duct tape, cardboard and plastic, Got a square peg to fit in a round hole and three men's lives were saved. It appears that in the whole pandemic situation, there was a bunch of scientists and doctors who raced ahead to get a vaccine.

And they were concentrating all their efforts on that. And then you had the doctors, the likes of Pierre Corry and Dr. Peter McCullough and others. He said, right, while they're doing that, let's go and have a look in the closet and see what we've got that we can use now while we wait to save lives. And then when they did find the remedies, And they were having success, they came back to Mission Control in Houston and said, Here's the solution.

We can start saving lives now while you guys are looking at a vaccine. And what happened? They were cancelled. They were censored. And so were the drugs that they were recommending were outlawed. It must be frustrating for people like yourself. And the first question I want to ask you is, How successful was Warp Speed?

Well, in terms of rushing a vaccine that was untested and unproven to market quickly is, you know, smashing success, you know, from a standpoint of producing a vaccine that was safe and effective, I think it was a miserable failure. But the problem is, as you rightly pointed out, I mean, the reason they sabotage early treatment, one of the reasons, If you had an effective treatment, it would be more difficult to get an emergency use authorization that could bypass all those tests.

So you could run it through our defense department with the, you know, other transactional authority process. Um, so it was crucial for the people that, uh, were just hell bent on producing this vaccine and using this MRN8 platform that could be highly profitable, uh, now and in the future. Uh, they had to sabotage early treatment and they did so, they did so very effectively.

And now, uh, that we have things like the VAERS report, and we have the yellow card system, we have, uh, you know, different systems throughout the world that are, that are showing, you know, the excess deaths, uh, you know, people like Ed Dowd and, and some of the, these insurance executives, that they're talking about excess deaths and excess disabilities, particularly with young people.

You know, now, now that the truth is, is being revealed, it's still being suppressed because the, the people that suppressed early treatment, uh, that pushed the vaccines. They can't afford to be proven wrong. I mean, the body count is way too high. And the problem we have, you know, unlike Apollo 13, where everybody was pulling in the same direction, everybody had the same goal at this point, the covert cartel.

Their goal is to again continue to push the mRNA platform a mass vaccination campaign. And not just for this, but for just about every other potential disease. Uh, and suppress the truth because the truth will be damning to them. Again, the body count is way too high and they've got the power. I mean, when I, when I talk about the COVID cartel in the U S I'm talking about the body administration, I'm talking about a federal health agencies that have been thoroughly captured by big pharma and big pharma is also captured our media and the big tech media, social, social giants or big tech, social media giants.

That is the COVID cartel. So they are a powerful group. Throw on top of that the World Economic Forum, Karl Schwab, uh, the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, the World Health Organization, uh, the Wellcome Trust. Uh, you know, these are the people, these are the elites that have, uh, imposed, uh, the pandemic fear on, on the world to allow them to roll out and impose on us a mass vaccination program using this mRNA technology.

So again, They have the same goal. They're not backing away from it. That's why they're looking at these WHO treaties. That's why they're bringing out this mRNA platform for veterinary medicine for different types of viruses. This is a game plan, and they're not backing away from it. John. Yeah. Look, Senator.

The, uh, the rates of, uh, excess deaths and, and vaccine injury as indicated in those very, um, telling grass on your, um, your own page under, under Covid. Uh, they're horrific. Uh, you know, when you think of 17,000, uh, deaths from the Covid vaccines, uh, you know, well exceeding even that for, for paracetamol, I mean, it, it is an outrage that.

So many medical officers from around the world and so many, um, previously peer reviewed experts, people like Dr. Peter McCullough, Pierre Corey in our country, uh, uh, Dr. Philip Altman and many others, uh, Angus Dalgleish, uh, professor of oncology in the UK, all now calling for these MRNA Uh, shots to be stopped, uh, due to the, uh, due to the failure of it and, and the safety and the risk, but it just doesn't seem to go anywhere.

I mean, officials, um, are obviously aware of it, but, uh, the media won't report on it. Uh, how do we get traction? Well, what we're trying to do here. I mean, we've got a, unfortunately, relatively small group of individuals, doctors, medical professionals, media types, people like yourselves, uh, that are trying to, uh, uncover and then expose the truth.

Uh, but again, we're up against powerful forces. You know, I was concerned about, uh, the vaccines, uh, even before they were approved, because I was talking to people like Michael Yeadon. He was a vice president at Pfizer for 30 years, ended up as the VP of R& D, degrees in toxicology, continued to work with Pfizer, with his own biotech company, so I mean, he's obviously on board with the pharmaceutical solutions.

He was appalled. He could not believe what he heard his colleagues were going to do, develop something, it's not a vaccine, it's a gene therapy, but an injection that was going to have your body produce its own toxin. What could go wrong using a lipid nanoparticle that was designed to permeate difficult barriers that they knew was going to biodistribute all over the body, and they were lying to us.

He said, Ron, they're lying to us. I know they're lying to us. I know they know they're lying to us. So, you know, that was my first awareness of being concerned about this, the vaccine being produced by Operation Warp Speed. But then I started looking at VAERS, and very early on, this was probably March of 2021, VAERS had a few thousand deaths.

Forty at that time, 40 or 46 percent of those deaths were occurring on the day of vaccination or within one or two days. Here we are three years later, on the VAERS system worldwide, we have over 37, 000 deaths

associated with COVID vaccine and about 24 percent of those are occurring on the day of vaccination or within one or two days.

Now, the FDA, the CDC, in October of 2020, before they got the emergency use authorization, they were bragging about the VAERS system. They were touting it. They were saying, you know, we've got this fabulous safety surveillance system called VAERS. We're going to be monitoring that. If people lose a couple days worth of work because of an adverse reaction to the vaccine, we're going to be on the phone, we're going to be following up on that to find out exactly what's happening.

That was total BS. The minute Vaers started showing, uh, the, the signals that were screaming that should have been screaming at these people, they started denigrating vaers, you, oh, this is you, you know, probably a bunch of cranks getting on there. You know, a bunch of anti-vaxxers, uh, falsely loading information, even though it's a felony to a load.

False information in the Vayar system. So again, you, you take a look at their behavior throughout, uh, you know, the lockdowns, the masks that, uh, Fauci knew wouldn't work, and all of a sudden he's recommending three or four of them. None of this ever made sense to me in 2020, the fact that, uh, they weren't, they didn't have an operation warp speed on generic medicines, you know, like, uh, ivermectin, like corticosteroids, like, uh, hydroxychloroquine, like budesonide.

I mean, there's literally a cornucopia of drugs that could have been used effectively to treat. They just simply didn't didn't do it. So we had in the U. S. We had hospital protocols relied on remdesivir. It was pulled from the boa trout because people were dying faster with when that was part of the protocol.

The who recommended against remdesivir. But that's the standard of care. Plus, ventilation were about 90 percent of people who were ventilated never came off ventilation. They died. So we literally had hospital protocols that I believe probably killed more people than they saved. Senator, we've interviewed several military aviation specialists in America, Teresa Long, Lieutenant Colonel and Lieutenant Colonel Pete Chambers, former Green Beret.

And they're very, very concerned about the level of illness from vaccinated aviators in the military at the moment. And one military aviation specialist in the Navy came out recently and reported that the military version of VAERS has shown a 1000 percent increase in cardiac arrest amongst military pilots.

That surely has to have people on Capitol Hill concerned. No, it doesn't. You know, we, we had a Tom Renz, uh, reveal this in my COVID 19 second opinion event in January of 2020, you know, the problem with the, what they call the DMED system, you know, showing, you know, that type of increase in myocarditis, but also all forms of cancer and, and, you know, women gynecological problems, that type of thing.

So, I mean, just across the board, Uh, the DMAT system was screaming at us as well. Yeah, we, we asked Lloyd Austin, you know, Department of Defense, what's happening here, and all of a sudden, oh, there's a glitch in the system. Oh, no kidding. Well, explain the glitch. Uh, here, here we are two years later, they haven't explained the glitch.

So they're covering something up. Um, again, this is across the board. The cover up in our in the U. S. Federal health agencies, but but also in health agencies around the world and certainly within media, which vilified doctors like Peter McCulloch and Pierre Corey and others. They're in the tank for this.

They again the body count is too high. They can't afford to be proven wrong, and they have the power to make it very difficult proven wrong. That's what we're up against. Does it frighten you, for example, in Australia we have people like our own Dr. Philip Altman who worked in pharmacology for so long, uh, 40 odd years working with our TGA and ATAGI and our other government regulatory bodies.

They're convinced that there is an under reporting ratio that could be up to 100%, and 100 times I should say. And so many medical professionals in Australia are terrified to report an adverse reaction. Are you finding that in the States as well? Yeah, absolutely. I think there's a Harvard study that said that only 1 percent of adverse events were reported on VAERS.

Others say it's probably only 10%. So I think the underreporting is a significant factor here, which is why in the U. S. we had a very interesting public opinion poll by Rasmussen, and that poll said about 50 percent of Americans believe they know someone who died from the vaccine. Now, that is a shocking poll, but that poll has been covered up as well.

So again, nobody knows the exact figure. I know there are people out there like Denny Rancourt, uh, estimating that maybe the vaccine killed 17 million people. I don't know. That's, those are mathematical models that's making all kinds of assumptions. You know, I'm just looking at the hard data and, you know, when I started publishing my chart on the VAERS data, which compared, you know, drugs from the FAERS system, the FDA adverse event reporting system, things like.

Hydroxychloroquine, things like ivermectin that seem relatively safe, you know, based on years and years of, and billions of doses used, plus, you know, what reports on the FAIR system, you compare that to remdesivir and particularly the COVID vaccines, there's no comparison. You know, the, the stats on this are, are tremendous.

So, you know, you also, you often hear, well, you know, all those deaths, well, take a look at how many doses. So you look at number of doses, deaths per dose for the COVID vaccine is about 25. 5. So 25. 5 deaths per million dose of the COVID vaccine, the flu vaccine, it's about 0. 46. So that's a 55 fold increase deaths per million doses, uh, COVID vaccine over the flu vaccine.

And yet our fed health officials are saying nothing to see here. This is safe and effective. You've got the Nobel prize being awarded claiming with, with no study. You know, then again, a mathematical model that you can easily, uh, probably corrupt saying that, oh, 14, say, 14 million lives will prove that, uh, again, so I'm just looking at hard data and the hard data is very difficult to refute, but they're doing a pretty good job of ignoring it.

John. Yes, Senator. Um, I think a lot of people, uh, probably in Australia, at least and, and likely in, in, uh, America, uh, would believe that. The administration, uh, President Trump obviously received some very, very bad intel and information on these vaccines from people like Fauci. Uh, we now know, uh, conclusively that these vaccines were never safe.

They were never effective. I mean, President Trump, uh, advocated for alternatives, uh, like hydroxychloroquine, uh, for instance, but he did maintain that the vaccines had saved lives. Do you think? And we hope that he is returned to the presidency. Um, certainly, uh, we, we, we wish that for America and the world, uh, do you think when he comes back that he'll review what's happened?

And you know, I think people want to see justice here. They, they want action. They want somebody to come in and not only clean up the swamp, but clean up these grubs that, that have done this to us. Yeah, I sure hope so. I met with him about a year ago. Down at Mar a Lago when one of the reasons I wanted to meet with him is I wanted to see what he had a sense for, you know, really how he was undermined with his own administration.

And I asked him point blank because he had initially assigned Bobby Kennedy to head a task force to look at childhood vaccine injuries. And he told me the story. He had a woman that worked for him in the Trump organization. She had a beautiful little boy, you know, got vaccinated and that little boy has never been the same since.

So I think he's, he's aware of it. And he's concerned about it. You know, certainly if, if he wins the presidency and particularly if, if, if we get a majority in the Senate as Republicans, you know, right now I'm ranking member on the permanent subcommittee of investigation. This is supposedly the premier oversight investigatory committee within the Senate.

You know, unfortunately we're, we're grossly underfunded, but one of the reasons as ranking member, I've sent something like more than 60 oversight letters. On some aspect of COVID to the federal health agencies, department of defense and others is just lay the foundational groundwork for when, if, and when I become chairman of that committee and have very strong subpoena authority and I'll start hauling these people in front of my committees.

And quite honestly, I will be setting up forums where the doctors who have been talking about Uh, early treatment. The doctors who have been warning us about the, the, the safety issues with these vaccines, where they actually get a chance to discuss and debate with the people who pushed them. You know, all these public events I've, I've been doing, uh, starting in, in June of 2021, where I gave a forum to, to vaccine injured individuals like Bree Dressen and Cheryl Rutgers and Manny DeGarry.

Almost every one of these things I've invited, uh, the heads of or representatives of federal health agencies of these pharmaceutical companies, They just refuse to engage in debate. You know, Steve Kirsch has, you know, a challenge to, to, you know, these people who debate him, uh, you've got Peter Hotez on the Joe Rogren program.

I think that the dollar was up to 2. 6 million donated to a charity of his choice, if he would just debate a lawyer. About these vaccines. In other words, debate Bobby Kennedy, who again, who's very able debater, but why would a medical professional who's been pushing vaccines, why would they shirk at all from debating or discussing vaccine safety with a lawyer, particularly when there's two, one, 2.

6 million on the table for their charity of their choice. It just shows you these people are running scared. They can't defend their position. Uh, so I'm going to do everything I can if I become chairman of that committee. Uh, to set up those discussions, those debates and hold these people accountable.

Senator over here in Australia, we've had one particular senator for a minor party pushing very hard to have a Senate inquiry into the excess deaths in Australia. That has two out of three times failed on party policy lines. In other words, the governing the governing party at the moment is the Labour Party, joined by a minor party, the Greens.

They all voted on party lines against wanting to find out what's killing Australians. I mean, I'm perplexed by that. And, uh, and we've seen that slowly come back and we had one person cross the line which got the vote true. We don't know whether there will be an investigation, but at least they've opened the door.

What we're noticing, which is enjoyable for some of us, is there's a certain bipartisanship amongst a small handful of politicians and lawmakers in Canberra. From three or four different parties, we have maybe six politicians. Who are fighting the good fight like you are, but they speak to an empty chamber and the pushback they're getting is horrendous.

They can't get any traction for love nor money. How are you finding it in the States at the moment? How many are on your side? And is there a sense of bipartisanship from both parties? I have a couple fellow Republican senators who will listen to me. Uh, there, there are a couple of house members, uh, you know, Marjorie Taylor green, uh, people like, uh, Thomas Massey.

There are a few others, uh, that. Have been in her. I'll call them rogue hearing. She's part of the she's part of the subcommittee on the investigation of the coronavirus. Okay, but that's chaired by a doctor full fledged member of the medical community, the establishment. They recently held a hearing with People like Peter Marks.

He's he's the guy sort of in charge of the FDA in terms of these vaccines and it was not a fact finding measure. It was more of a hearing to restore the credibility and integrity. I think they utterly failed those agencies. So no, we do not have any bipartisanship here at all. We have very few members either in the House or the Senate who

are willing to even talk about this because they've seen the way people like me have been vilified and ridiculed and, and, uh, It hasn't, it hasn't, you know, it's not something they want to engage in.

So from, from, you know, in the States here, this is an issue where, uh, like almost nobody really wants to delve into this. I mean, they don't want to take a look at what our, how miserable, what a miserable failure our response to COVID was because most of them voted for. The trillions of dollars of spending to shut down the economy that just truly, you know, literally wasted trillions of dollars that they they produce videos encouraging their constituents to get get the jab.

They don't just like doctors. I mean, doctors who push this on their patients that they don't want to. recognize the reality that maybe some of those shots might have killed people or permanently disabled them. Nobody wants to face that reality. Nobody wants to admit they're wrong. So they just ignore it.

They just, let's, let's move on. So in the U S I think there's more of an effort of just, Hey, listen, that tough times back then we had imperfect information, uh, the boy, there was some incorrect decisions made there. Nobody will say exactly what those incorrect decisions were, but. Let's just move on, you know, let's grant absolution anybody who might have made a bad decision and let's move on and let's support the who treaty, which, which now that that is a partisan issue.

You know, I had an amendment on the Senate floor that would have deemed that a treaty, you know, the who amendments and the agreements are working on the who that, you know, unfortunately may come to fruition here within 70 days. Uh, deem that a treaty and every Republican except for the Republican co sponsoring the bill is amended would have amended voted in favor of deeming that a treaty.

Every Democrat voted against deeming that a treaty to bring it before the Senate for debate and ratification. So, uh, the, the who treaties, which I think I hoping. Smaller countries are highly skeptical of, uh, that's a partisan issue here, but we're not really gaining traction with this administration to, to prevent that from being ratified.

You think a Trump White House will draw a line through the who? Well, I think, yeah, I think Trump, uh, is, is highly skeptical of the, who would want to pull the U S out of it, uh, probably want to pull the U S out of the UN quite honestly. So that'd be one advantage of lucky Donald Trump. Absolutely. John.

Yeah, well, look, mandates, uh, Senator, they've been a massive issue here. We, we've experienced, uh, I mean, people can't believe it. I mean, we talk, we, we speak to people from around the world and they can't believe what's gone on in little old Australia. You know, people locked down for months, people fired upon with, uh, rubber bullets at, uh, war, war memorials.

Uh, protesting against mandates, uh, it's just been completely mad. People mandated out of frontline jobs because, uh, they're at risk of transmitting diseases. Uh, COVID, uh, chief health officers giving evidence in Supreme Court saying that these paramedics and doctors can't go to work, uh, because there are risks to everyone.

Did this go on to this extent in the US? I have to admit, I, I, I watched an amazement in terms of what was happening in Australia. We, we certainly had an attempt in mandates, and there it was mandate, obviously in the military, which was a real travesty in some workplaces, uh, you know, in airlines, for example.

Um, and in, in the medical institutions. And so there, there were a lot, there were a lot of nurses that, uh, quit because of it. I think there, there were some doctors, uh, but, but in the end, uh, the, the mandates, uh, went away. Uh, I hate to say relatively fast, but there aren't mandates really in place. I mean, there's still a few mandates universities, unbelievably, even those that, you know, young, healthy kids have virtually no risk whatsoever from covid.

And that's really what's been such a shame is, you know, as much as Anthony Fauci claimed to be the science, you know, the policy prescriptions under covid were completely non scientific based. We knew it early on from

the from the Diamond Princess cruise ship that, uh, yeah, this could be a deadly disease for the elderly people, certain comorbidities.

But if you're young, it could be an acid disease. It could be an asymptomatic disease, you know, but you're not going to probably suffer grave consequences if you're young. But we still, you know, recommended these things for children six months and older. Uh, even though we realized at the time that, uh, there was a, they were at least acknowledging a higher risk of myocarditis in young males.

So they completely ignored the science, they ignored the science on masks, the, you know, these shutdowns, which have never been, you know, a part of, uh, the recommendation during a pandemic. You know, you can't shut down an economy. Uh, I spoke out loudly against that in March of 2020, wrote a column in USA Today, I was vilified for it, you know, accused of wanting to kill people.

But yeah, so we certainly had a lot of people over the top here in the U. S. But I must say, Australia outdid us. I'm hoping it's become a little more normalized now. That's one question I had for you folks. Is it settled down there? Is it still pretty bad? Well, there's a whole bunch of people out of work.

And my wife and I have spent the last 15 months towing a caravan around Australia, 70, 000 kilometers. We've spoken to 30, 000 people at 300 venues just to try and bring them together as a community. And our country's spirit has been decimated, Senator. It has been destroyed. There would have been a time, not too long ago, where if the world went to hell in a handbasket, most people would pick either Canada, Australia, or New Zealand to find haven.

And we have become three of the most draconian countries on the planet. And I think the World Economic Forum has a lot to answer for in that regard. But, you know, my friend John here, he has six children. His wife is 25 years a registered nurse with a degree in clinical teaching. Um, they have been making coffee for a living.

I mean, Australia is decimated. And the one thing we said at the Senate the other day, is that this is happening on your watch and you must listen to the people of this country. Now, the people of this country are either asleep and dumbed down, they don't want to know, they're in denial, or they've been affected in a bad way.

We are importing nurses from other countries around the world to fill shifts in Australian hospitals while we have thousands of nurses sitting at home on their hands, unable to work. Still, to this day, paramedics like John, unable to go to work. Police officers, law enforcement, officers who, where some have been able to come back from extended leave without pay and go back into the workforce, but those who were terminated because they refused to go along with the mandate have had their termination letters signed under the, uh, under the reason being gross misconduct.

They can't get a job anywhere now. They can't get a job as a security officer because they have gross misconduct. They And police commissioners in this country, in various states, are saying that these officers who disobeyed the directive of the commissioner will never be employed in that role. And these are the people with the highest levels of integrity who are needed in this role now.

I mean, it's a disgrace, Senator. It is an absolute disgrace. This is so obviously insane, uh, that the COVID cartel has been able to do this to our societies. So again, you understand the power, you know, I was talking about all the lies that were told the public. Uh, I think one of the most egregious one was when they were denying natural immunity and you, you don't have to be a doctor to understand how insane this is.

So they were pushing a gene therapy that, that gene therapy, that, that we'll call it, we'll call it the COVID vaccine, that mRNA thing, that injection, what was it going to rely on to protect you? It was going to have the, you know, a person's natural immunity kick in to respond to that vaccine. What were they thinking happened when you actually got the virus?

Rather than just have a small portion of the virus, you know, the spike protein trigger the immune response. If you got COVID, you had the entire virus. So now your immune system is going to recognize the entire virus as opposed to only the spike protein, which was probably the most mutatable part. Of the coronavirus and in all these variants switch, which is one of the reasons why the vaccine simply wasn't effective because by the time they had it out, the coronavirus has already mutated into a different variant and again, your body didn't recognize that new type of spike protein.

So again, it was insane. That they would deny natural immunity and they did it again. They lied to people because they wanted everybody to get vaccinated. I mean, that's, that's how evil this was. I mean, it was evil. I there's no other way to describe this. Evil was perpetrated on society globally by, by these people who's pushed these vaccines.

They knew better. They were lying to us. They, they, as Michael Eden said, they knew they, they were lying to us, but they still lied to us and they're still getting away with it. By and large, they're getting away with it. There were families who were separated by border closures in Australia who couldn't cross a plastic barrier to go to a hospital that was within sight of where they were standing.

To be with their dying children or parents and yet football teams are allowed to fly interstate across those borders with their families and and participate in their sport. We have seen the most crazy stuff going on. Well, in America, in America, more than six million illegal immigrants have been able to come into our country, get encountered, process and disperse within eight hours.

No vaccination required. No, no, no kind of a health check to see if they have other antibiotic resistant, uh, diseases they may be carrying in here. You know, open up the border to the world and, you know, clamp down on, on the rest of society and take away their freedom. No, again, this has been insane. What has happened?

It's evil. What's happened. Well, I think people would be surprised to learn in, in, in the States that in New South Wales, the, the government under the, uh, under, under the premier here said that you couldn't sing or dance. But you could, you could talk that was allowed. You weren't allowed to go to church.

It was banned, but you could go to a brothel. Well, we, we, we, we, we probably do that. We couldn't go to church. They closed on churches, but liquor stores, they kept open. I'm not sure about brothels, probably. We don't have that many legal ones. Senator, we're about to undoubtedly face, and you're about to face election in America, which is probably will be the most watched election in world history.

When Americans elect a president for them, they actually elect a president for the rest of the world. We've got to be honest with that, about that. So everybody in Australia will be watching what goes on. Do you, I, I, I don't know where you stand either side, whether you're left or right or what factions you're in or if you're in any factions at all.

You seem like a moderate to me who's got an open mind. Do you have faith in the electoral system in America? I have my concerns. Uh, we have not done what we need to do to ensure that, uh, you know, everybody has confidence that our election system will be fair. You know, I mean, I'm concerned of, uh, you know, social media companies like Google using their search capability of, of, uh, you know, pushing public opinion in one direction.

I'm concerned about all the, uh, absentee ballots, all the mail in balloting and how we've relaxed the controls over that. Yeah, I'm concerned of, uh. You know, the type of money being funneled in these campaigns, some of the potentially illegally. So I think there's still all kinds of issues. You know, in my state in Wisconsin, uh, what we have done is, is we've, uh, recruited what we call election workers.

These are people that, uh, have signed up a year before the election. They get trained, they get paid, but it's eyes on the process. And we did that in 2022. And I think that had a pretty good effect, but our elections are run state by state. So it kind of depends state by state. Uh, you know, what kind of controls I think in blue states, uh, you know, Katie by the door.

Uh, make, make voting incredibly easy, even for illegal immigrants, uh, and in, in red states, I think we're probably clamping down on it. So it's going to be a mixed, mixed bag in terms of, uh, the integrity of elections state by state. Uh, I'm just hoping that, uh, enough Americans are awakened that, uh, any amount of cheating that does occur is just overwhelmed.

By people disgusted by the destruction of democratic governance and the Biden administration. And it is, it is unfortunate that, uh, what we do in America has such an impact around the world. And I, I completely understand that. But you know what, what, what Biden has done, you know, open borders, uh, massive deaths of spending, you know, the, the, the feckless, the, the dangerous surrender in Afghanistan, which emboldened, uh, Taiwans around, around the world.

It's weak in America. And when America is weak, the world's a more dangerous place. And so, so that's very unfortunate. Absolutely, and one weakening factor would be, uh, a dramatic weakening factor would be a civil war. How close is America to a civil war? Well, I, I hope not. Uh, but I, I do say that, you know, when I ran in 2010, I was concerned about the fact that we were mortgaging our children's future.

You know, globally. But particularly in the U. S. But we're 14 trillion in debt. Now we're 35 we're we're exacerbating the problem right now. I'd say the greatest threat to America is our division. I think the good news is we're not a naturally divided people, not not. In America, not globally. I mean, most people want the same things, right?

You know, we want safety, we want security. We want enough, uh, you know, job opportunities so we can take care of ourselves and our family, that those are universal goals that we share. Uh, so why are we so divided? It's because there are political groups, there are political figures that are purposefully dividing us.

In America, it's called identity politics. Things like critical race theory, uh, this whole issue of transgenderism. Listen, we're compassionate people. Any, anybody with true gender dysphoria, we have compassion for it, but now we're, we're pushing it on children. We're, we're suggesting to, to little toddlers that, yeah, maybe you're not a little boy, maybe a little girl, you know, let's, let's mutilate your body, which I find unbelievable in America that we literally doctors and nurses are taking minors.

And cutting off body parts all on the, the, the altar of transgenderism. So again, I think that division that's being so particularly here in America, but I think this is happening worldwide. I mean, that's certainly what the pandemic did. It divide us between the vaxxed and the unvaxed, you know, the clean and the unclean, um, that, that division is being pushed by people like Klaus Schwab and his accolades.

You know, people like Justin Trudeau, you know, whoever, you know, the Prime Minister of New Zealand, I mean, all these people attend the World Economic Forum and they all came back saying the exact same thing, we're going to build back better. I mean, if that's not a dead giveaway, how orchestrated this is from a global standpoint, a new world order, I don't know what is.

I mean, we're going to build back better. That wasn't something people just came up independently and just was a huge coincidence. It's, it's a bit at odds for me, uh, watching on from over here, the, the rise and rise and the, uh, and the shift to one side or the other of Elon Musk. Uh, he's seen as a champion of free speech in, in around the world at the moment.

And he's also one of the proponents of, uh, of transhumanism and, um, and artificial intelligence. Every now and then he calls for a moratorium on issues like that so we can take stock of what we're doing. And then other times he seems to promote it. Where do you see him in the big scheme of things? Well, first of all, currently, and I don't agree with everything, you know, all the tax credits is a Tesla company gets for American taxpayers for his electric vehicles.

But, you know, I truly appreciate what he's done on an X. I completely agree with him. We said, if we don't have a red wave, uh, America's over, uh, he certainly understands what the open border, what they're trying to do there. I mean, flood our country. Include those individuals who is illegal. Illegal aliens in the census count, which is going to increase the number of congressional seats.

Uh, Democrats have in some of these states. So, so he's he gets it. He understands the danger of this nation's in and I appreciate the fact that he's opened up X. As a social media platform that that is more open to free speech is not doing the censorship that the government directed censorship, that, uh, things like Facebook and other social media companies are doing.

So, uh, right now, I, I, I read, uh, Walter Isaacson book. I, I think he's brilliant. Uh, I, I, I love, you know, he, his engineering mind. I think he's taken a rocket launch down from, you know, when NASA would do it, cost a billion dollars down to about 70 million, allowing these boosters to, to, uh, land in, in, you know, synchronously, uh, on the landing pads.

I mean, he's just, he's an, he's accomplished amazing things. And, uh, I appreciate what he's doing in terms of speaking out and telling the truth.

Uh, Senator, I was gonna touch base with you on the, on the, uh, Red Cross. Uh, we've got issues in Australia about, uh, the blood products, obviously, with the spike proteins. I know that Red Cross have in America have, uh, got a questionnaire about whether you've had a vaccine, an mRNA vaccine, and they're asking you to call ahead, uh, before booking in.

What's, what's happening in the States in regards to, to that? What do you think of the long term plans? Are we going to have to have separate blood banks? Well, I think it's, it's an issue that's being largely ignored. Again, again, just, you know, about 70 percent of the American population got vaccinated.

Yeah. Yeah. They don't want to think they may have a ticking time bomb in their body. So again, they just want to forget it and move on. And, you know, so nobody's really, really understanding that the, the true possible, this possible problems with a blood supply. That's contaminated with spike protein that with the M RNA that we haven't done studies for exactly how long this M RNA remains in the body.

I mean, we were told is going to stay in the arm and you know, basically, you know, M RNA is just so vulnerable to destruction, but this is not real M RNA. This is modified. This is modified to actually last longer. And so I think the studies that I'm aware of, we know that it stays in the body for at least two, if not three months, but we haven't done studies beyond that.

Um, so, so who knows how long this MRNA Is impacting us, you know, quite honestly, now we know about the DNA contamination. We know that the, the, the gene, the gene therapy frame shift. So it's producing proteins other than the designated spike protein. We know the DNA is is a transfecting it's being translated in the actual cell into your own genetics.

Uh, could, could be what's causing some of these cancers, that type of thing. And we just don't know because we refuse to study it because. The COVID cartel doesn't want to know. They don't want to explore what, what disaster their, their vaccine might be causing us worldwide and for a very long period of time.

So again, we're just basically ignoring it. And that goes along with the blood supply. What do you know about a lobbying organization called Mercury LLC? I'm not aware of them. Not aware of them. Okay, I'll leave it there because we're still looking into that. We've, we've got some information, but anyway.

We'll talk about that another time. Um, the other, the other question I need to ask is, can you ever see a time? I mean, at the moment, I think it's more important that we're focusing on saving lives, the people who've been vaccine injured, those who aren't being treated properly. So we've gotta focus on saving lives, but there needs to come a time when people will be held, will be held to account and need to be.

Do you envisage a time where people like Fauci will stand trial? I, I'm not sure about stand trial, but again, if I, if, if we win the majority, I'm chairman of the permanent subcommittee investigations, I'll be subpoenaing him. You know, I, I'll be bringing him in to testify. Uh, so I mean the, the, that's again, to me, the, the first step, and I think the most important part of accountability is exposing the truth.

exposing what they've done. And again, it is as difficult a task as it is as powerful as the COVID cartel is. I think we should take some comfort in the fact that it's a very low uptake of all these boosters. I think people are seeing through it. They're, they're realizing that even though they may not want to admit it to themselves,

Uh, I think many, many people regret, uh, following the advice of people like Fauci, actually believing him. Uh, again, if you've read R. F. K. Jr. 's book, The Real Anthony Fauci, you'll understand exactly what a very bad person, and that's putting it mildly, Anthony Fauci is. I mean, he's an awful human being.

Awful. Yeah, he is. Speaking of Kennedy, how's he looking at the moment? Do you think he's going to have any impact on the election? You know, third party candidacies, it's very difficult in America. We're a two party political system here. It's not perfect, but it's served us quite well. Until the Democrats are becoming more and more likely to turn it into one party nation, that'd be pretty concerning.

But listen, I've gotten to know Bobby Kennedy. We've been fighting this fight together. I think he's a very good person. Uh, I personally wish he would have stayed in the Democrat party that, and, and that primary and, uh, challenged and beat Joe Biden. Uh, then I think we'd have a pretty interesting choice between Donald Trump and RFK Jr.

But, uh, that he didn't, he couldn't do that. I mean, the Biden's, you know, that's how undemocratic the Democrat party is. They simply wouldn't allow him to be in their primary. So, so he had to drop out of that and, and run as an independent. So we'll see how that goes. I mean, nobody can predict things. I mean, it's, it's hard to predict how things are gonna turn out.

John, Senator, we've spoken at the Senate inquiry here where with Tony Nicoli, one of our prominent solicitors about willful blindness, uh, professor Angus Dalglish, uh, a, a notable oncologist, uh, at the, uh, St. George's Hospital in London. He, he told. Uh, us on our program that, uh, these MRNA vaccines will make thalidomide look like a pimple on your bum.

Uh, where do we, where is this going to, you know, start and finish? I mean, these doctors, uh, that have been ordering these vaccines, they must know, you know, it's just crazy to think that they, they, they don't know what's going on and surely that they have got to bear responsibility. Well, some do. But again, just think of the natural human tendency to never admit you're wrong.

So certainly not even want to find out. So that's there's just a lack of, uh, curiosity here. Um, people just want to move on. And that that's what we're really up against here. Uh, I mean, the fact that, uh, they continue to suppress and and hide. You know, all this information, this mountain of information of excess deaths and excess disabilities in the military with young people, with, with working age individuals.

I mean, Ed Dow has done a great job. Just looking at this from a financial analyst viewpoint, you know, just looking at the numbers and yet our federal health agencies, the COVID cartel, the media, they're, they're just completely ignoring it. I mean, you'll get, you'll get the one off. News stories and a local station about somebody and I've seen, you know, the compilation of these things of, you know, somebody getting a shot and immediately being paralyzed or whatever.

I mean, so you have some of that, but there's no followup on it. You know, there was a big, there was a news story. Uh, I think this is in the fall of 2021 where the CEO of One America was on a podcast somewhere and he was talking about their, their death data coming in and they were seeing 40%. excess deaths.

Uh, and he said, you know, a 10 percent increase in excess deaths. I mean, let's say dying in a population is a very regular thing. I mean, it's very predictable. It's very statistical. And so a 10 percent increase in deaths like that would have been a one in 200 year event. They had a 40, they were looking at a 40 percent increase.

Now I tried to follow up with that company and all the other insurance companies, and I couldn't get squat. in terms of their data. I mean, they're all hanging together here and nobody's releasing this data. So it's, it's really quite remarkable. And now we're hearing that, uh, you know, globally, some of these health ministries and health agencies, they're, they're redefining the definition of, of deaths and excess deaths.

I mean, they're going to be cooking the books. They're going to be doctoring the numbers. Off topic a little. I know we've got to let you go very shortly. You're very busy, but um, net zero has become a really big issue in Australia. And, uh, our renewables policy is an absolute disaster, as I'm sure it is in America.

Where do you, where do you guys, the Republicans, stand on net zero? Well, unfortunately, we've got Republicans that buy into climate change. I don't. Uh, I, I don't see how you can take a look at a trace element, which is a, just a fraction of a percentage of our total atmosphere, where 97 percent of that trace element is naturally produced.

And only 3 percent comes from mankind and say that. We are forcing global climate change. When you take a look at the Vostok ice core sample and you look at it, honestly, and you realize that CO2 is actually a lagging indicator from temperature, which makes sense is, is the oceans warm, which is most where Earth's CO2 is locked up when the ocean's warm.

You know, CO2 is released, so temperature increases, CO2 increases, it's not necessarily the inverse there, so again, I'm just a skeptic, uh, I don't think we should be spending a dime on it, I'm in the Bjorn Lombard camp who believes in man made global warming, but realizes there's nothing we can do about it, we're gonna have to adapt, so I think the whole push toward, you know, on climate change and spending trillions of dollars trying to combat it is, is completely lunatic, it's a complete waste of money, Uh, even if we, you know, even if we had to try and, uh, hold back the tides, we, we can't, you know, one statistic's never been challenged, but because it's true, everybody's concerned about the, the rise in, in sea levels, right?

Do you know how much the sea level has increased in the Bay of San Francisco since the last glaciation period, about 20, 000 years ago? 390 feet. I mean, that's only 20, 390 feet. Do you think man could have done anything to prevent that rise in time? Of course we couldn't. So again, this is crazy, but just like the pandemic, they're using the fear over something like climate change.

Remember, it used to be global cooling, then global warming. And finally, so let's just call it climate change. They scare people. It's exactly what Eisenhower warned us about in his, uh, Farewell address. His fourth warning was we cannot allow global society to descend, to descend into a state of dreadful fear and hate.

Well, that's where we are. We have, we have people pushing hate, pushing division, and they're pushing all these things to make society afraid so they can gain control over us. That's where we're at. And now this push to give these who treaties is going to kind of, that'll be their capstone event. Where they can declare emergencies and take away people's sovereignty.

national sovereignty, but personal sovereignty over your own health freedom. It's, it's pretty, pretty scary prospect right now. And you know, most, most legislators are asleep at the wheel here. Scary prospect, Johnny, final question from you, man. Yeah. Thanks. Uh, what do you look, uh, there's been a lot of, uh, obviously manipulation by bureaucrats and politicians and elites.

We've got a, uh, A former prime minister who happens to be the, uh, attache or the representative of our country in, in Washington, Washington, Kevin Rudd. Ambassador. Ambassador. He's hit the media today, uh, because, uh, President Trump was asked by Nigel Farage about, uh, uh, comments that, uh, Kevin Rudd had made about, uh, President Trump.

And, uh, the president, uh, went on to, uh, So that, uh, you heard that he was a little bit nasty and, and that he wasn't the brightest bulb. And, uh, uh, if he was at all hostile, he wouldn't be in Washington for too long. Um, I imagine that will be the case, I hope. Um, but what do you think about these people being planted, uh, in the strategic places to get rid of, uh, President Trump and, and to stop him from coming back, do you, do you think that this world economic forum, they are just really crapping their pants about him coming back?

Yeah, I looked at Donald Trump. I said this in 2016, he's the political equivalent of a disruptive technology. And you know, the, the political mainstream, they don't like disruptive technologies. They don't like disruption. They've got a game plan. They're sticking to it. Uh, yeah, I never subscribed to global conspiracies, but you have to admit when you take a look at, uh, What the videotape themselves saying, you know, call Schwab and his henchmen when you see that that compilation reel of all these world leaders who have attended the World Economic Forum for years, you know, the Davos.

Clan when they all are talking, you know, sing out the same hymn book, the same lyrics, you know, build back better, uh, the same playbook in terms of shutdowns and vaccine passports and that type of thing, you know, embracing what they're going to do with, with the who amendments and the who treaties. Um, you, you've got to really scratch your head and come to the realization that there's a, an elite group of people, uh, in this world that exert way too much influence over all of our lives that that needs to be broken.

And I think a lot of people in Australia would have forgotten, uh, by now that Kevin Rudd, uh, back in 2021 was actually, uh, hailed as a hero because we couldn't get any Pfizer. Uh, so they're trying to look outside of that to, you know, get their policy prescriptions, uh, that would run afoul of, of, uh, our constitution.

So, no, it's, it's a real concern. I think that, you know, with all the problems, you know, the vaccine injuries, I mean, you know, all the assaults on our freedom. I think that was the. The most concerning thing during the pandemic is how many Americans, how many people globally, how many Australians just willingly gave up their freedoms for a very false sense of security.

Um, it's the power of fear and, and these propagandists, uh, you know, the people from the world economic forum, these elites, they understand exactly how powerful fear is, how they can use that to gain greater power. And that's all they're into. They just want more power. They want more control. Uh, we need to resist it, but we need more people awakening to the urgency of the moment, uh, with their eyes open, uh, and, and, and ignoring what we're seeing out of the mainstream media.

Uh, that, that's the problem, and people get their news from the mainstream media, and the mainstream media is a card carrying member of the COVID cartel. Well, that's where we need to end it, I think, because that sums it up pretty well, and most people are starting to wake up to that fact now. The vaccination rate in Australia has dropped by 85%.
