

2024-07-18 - Graham and John speak with Dr Brian Hooker...

Well, hi, everyone. It's Thursday, the 18th of July at seven o'clock in the morning on the east coast of Australia. And it's mid afternoon where our special guest is, uh, Dr. Brian Hooker is joining us tonight, uh, from the west coast of the USA, Brian.

Yes. Yes. From California. And, and, and thank you so much, Graham and John, for having me on your show.

Great. It's great to have you on now, John, you know, we were just talking to Brian before we, uh, we came on air. Dr. Brian Hooker is our special guest, John, you and I were just plodding along with life until the pandemic happened. And then we got prodded into life by the fact that governments just went crazy.

They, they applied the mandates. We looked at why are they applying the mandates because it all seems so crazy and it didn't seem worth all the trouble that we were going through and they woke us up and they haven't been able to shut us up since we're not going anywhere because of this, they overcooked the goose.

We've said that a thousand times. Um, and John, here we have a man who is, is held up in high regard by a great many people in Australia who like you and I have woken up. Um, and, uh, we're going to unpack his story in a moment, but I mean, your perspective on all of this, John. You were, you were a paramedic at 25 years.

Um, you said, hang on, this is crazy. I'm not, I can't see the sense in this at all. You saw a lot of evidence to say that we were going down the wrong path through your job. I was an airline captain with Qantas for 32 years. And I saw the same things happening. I couldn't make sense of it all. And here we are talking to distinguished people like our guests today.

I mean, how's the last three years been for you, Johnny?

Well, I think that was a pretty good summary, Hoody, uh, look, it's, it's, it's really, uh, unfortunate in a lot of ways, but I, I think we should really celebrate some aspects of it because I think it's opened the door, opened the window to, to, uh, exploring what has really been, Uh, potentially happening here and I can, I can honestly say that I was always, uh, never a fan of getting the flu vaccine.

Uh, I had it once very early on and I got very, very sick, uh, and I didn't have it, um, after that for, for quite some time and I, I can only ever recall having it. Uh, one or two doses of it ever. Uh, so I've never been an absolute fan of them. Um, but we went along with the, uh, with, with the vaccination of six children.

Uh, didn't, didn't question the narrative of, uh, of the main, uh, The mainstream thinking, uh, because we, we thought it was, you know, obviously the right thing to do. And, um, those people screaming from the sidelines were nutbags. Uh, but as it turns out, those nutbags were anything but, um, and when I think back over 25 years, Uh, to, uh, particularly those SIDS cases that we, we would have gone to, um, how likely is it that, uh, those cases, uh, may have had some link, uh, to these childhood vaccines?

And, you know, the thing that worries me most of all, and I think the, the real red flag here is that, uh, they keep telling you, uh, no, it's nothing to do with it, but they don't care. Want to expand on it. They're not happy to have any, uh, investigation. They're not happy to open up the book and say, well, let's, let's have a, let's have a review of this.

Let's all just sit together in the one room and have a look. I mean, I think if they did that, uh, you know, and, and, and we came to some agreement on, on, on it going forward, I think it would be better for everyone.

Absolutely. And, uh, I guess today, Dr. Brian Hooker, uh, came to prominence, uh, because Brian, you have a son who is autistic.

Am I right?

Correct.

Yeah. And as a result of that, that autism, you started to make some inquiries. Now we'll, we'll get you to unpack your, your, uh, your credentials very shortly. But I want to, I want to say this to take people back 60 years. Uh, when I was going to primary school and high school, virtually every class I ever attended had.

Somebody in that class who had polio and had their leg in irons or something like that. One of my best friends, Chris, had his leg in irons and he used to, you know, he was still a great outdoorsy kind of guy. And every class had a child who was suffering the horrendous effects of thalidomide. Uh, you know, with a, with a deformed arm, just a hand just sticking out of their shoulder.

And the bullying that went on with those guys was unbelievable. So when you think about it, I, I spoke to Chris recently and he overcame his polio. He's fine. He's had a normal life. Um and I don't understand why or how but the people who went through the thalidomide disaster, they, they've still got a deformed body and the sad part about that is that the polio seemed to work itself out but the thalidomide, the, the big pharmaceutical companies.

Uh, uh, um, plan to stop women from suffering morning sickness. Deformed so many people who are still stuck with it. So it seemed like Big Pharma caused more harm in those days than, than did, um, the illnesses that they were trying to beat. So I want to take everyone back to that time. That's what it was like.

And now, as a result of the work that you've been doing, uh, Brian, and the research that you've done, you have brought out the fact that, hang on, the autism that we're having at the moment may well be affected by, uh, by childhood vaccinations, in particular, MMR, measles, mumps, rubella. I had measles. I had mumps.

I'm still okay. Some people think I've got two heads, but we seem to go through these things as kids. I had chicken pox. I had all those things and every kid had them. And it was no big deal for most of us. For 99 percent of it, it was no big deal. But then you, you started to expand on this research that you did to highlight the fact that you believe that autism is being largely caused by, by childhood vaccination.

I've lost a three week old grandson to AIDS. Um, after he was vaccinated, these things caused me great concern and you were widely castigated. I mean, I've been researching some of the stuff that you've, you've done and some of the, the things that you've been through, and I can't believe the effort that was put in to counter everything that you said and to cancel you out going way, way back.

So forgive the lengthy explanation because now I want to turn it over to you. I want you to, Tell our audience who are going to be watching by the thousands. Um, tell them why you, why you're here, what credentials you have in the first place, because we know you're a doctor and what the journey has been like for you since you discovered this.

Well, thank you so much, Graham. Uh, I appreciate that, that introduction and your thoughts also, um, regarding polio as well as, uh, thalidomide. Um, my, uh, doctorate I, I received back in 1990 in biochemical engineering. And so that was sort of a blend between biology, chemistry, molecular biology, Uh, and, and engineering.

I, I started out as a chemical engineer, uh, and kind of stayed that course as an undergrad until I figured out that I was going to have to work in an oil refinery, which was sort of the last place that I wanted to be. Um, and, and in my graduate work. Uh, I was exposed to genetic engineering. Um, I, uh, did, uh, research in genetic engineering of, of, uh, plants.

This was not GMOs for food, but we were actually making human proteins. We were making blood proteins for things like bloodless medicine. Um, and you know, I, I worked for a department of energy laboratory after my PhD for about 16 years. Uh, I've worked in academia since then. I'm minding my own business.

Uh, but I was very pro vaccine and, uh, my son was born in 1998. And, you know, I was so pro vaccine that I grew up in a family where my mom was in charge of distribution of vaccines in a very large county in Southern California. And so, you know, quite frankly, I didn't know what an adverse event was. I had no clue.

You know, it just, I remember signing some of the vaccine information sheets that were woefully inadequate. didn't really disclose anything, uh, and it said something like one in a million or whatever, and signing it and thinking, Oh, well, this is great. My son will never get chickenpox. Well, you know, uh, he received his childhood vaccines, many of them contained mercury.

He was sort of tracking slow until about his 15 month well baby checkup, and he received three vaccines that day, all while having an active ear infection. And this was the first time that we really caught him. question the practitioner. It was a nurse practitioner and said he's sick. Should we vaccinate him?

She's like, Oh no, it's no problem. We do it all the time. Well, it was a big problem and he fevered, uh, for about 18 days after that, the fever spiked, uh, at about one Oh three. And then he very, very quickly. Uh, became just sort of a medical disaster. I mean, you know, it was like an atomic bomb went off in his gastrointestinal system.

Uh, he could not have a solid bowel movement. I mean, we just had weeks and months and up to years of diarrhea. And at the same time, very quickly, he lost all of his cognitive ability, his language, his eye contact. For a while, he even refused to walk unassisted because we believe that his gait and his balance were affected that day.

And then at 18 months, he was diagnosed with full blown autism. So, uh, you know, and we, it was so obvious to us, uh, that we knew something was going on with the vaccinations. We knew he was also mercury toxic. Uh, from to Marisol that was in the vaccines that he received, and we were fortunate to find a practitioner when he was about two months old or two years old, excuse me, that said no more vaccines, none.

And that resonated with my wife and I, and that started my journey investigating, you know, the Centers for Disease Control, um, researching this, and, you know, since then, my son is now 26 years old, um, still does not have the capacity to speak, uh, he's doing much, much better through interventions medically, uh, for him, but he still needs Definitely autistic.

And so it's been this 18, you know, uh, longer than 18, I'm sorry, about uh, uh, 22, 23 year ride where I've been investigating the CDC. I've been doing independent research and it have basically aligned my career. So I could look specifically at vaccine adverse events at vaccine injury, you know, not only for the, uh, Tamir cell containing vaccines in the MMR.

But other vaccines and other vaccine side effects.

Wow. Well, you, you don't come to this lightly, do you? I mean, and, and you came into this research obviously with a, you must've had some kind of bias given what your son had gone through, but it's not a bias that's, that's corrupted. It's a bias that's, that is seeking to find truth.

I mean, we go back, John, not too long ago, maybe it is now I'm talking about the 1960s where doctors were recommending cigarettes. Certain types of cigarettes were good for your health. Now, uh, that's it. We know that to be the opposite. You know, they're now putting all these horrible packaging out with pictures of people's lungs eaten away and all that sort of stuff.

Doctors in the medical profession and medical science get it wrong all the time. And it's, but it seems Brian, the minute you talked about autism related to MMR, they just sit upon you like a bunch of hounds. Why do you think that is?

Well, you know, there's so much industry capture in government, and I think that it's endemic, you know, we talk about it, I talk about from my perspective in the United States, looking at the Food and Drug Administration, looking at the CDC, and then looking at how much pharmaceutical advertising goes into, you know, the mainstream media.

Um, and, and I believe that, you know, whenever you talk about vaccines causing any type of adverse events, you've got a tiger by the tail. And so, we know it's going to be a rough ride. Uh, even, you know, when, uh, you know, I worked with a whistleblower from the CDC, a gentleman by the name of Dr. William Thompson, who really broke the fact that the CDC had committed fraud.

You know, regarding specifically the MMR and autism in African American males in, you know, in the United States, it was a, it was a sample of, uh, children in metropolitan Atlanta. Um, and he showed that, uh, they were 3.5 times more likely to get an autism diagnosis when they got the MMR on time versus if they just would have waited until they were after three years old.

And so breaking this, uh, Um, story was, you know, it was, it should have gone to the mainstream press. I begged reporters to look at this. But then, you know, after that happened, I had published a paper about this, the paper was retracted. And then all of a sudden, the retraction of the paper was wrongfully retracted.

And, and, you know, it had the CDC's fingerprints all over it. They did not want that in the mainstream scientific literature. And so that became the story, you know, CNN covered it, ABC News covered it, NBC News covered it, but it wasn't that the fact that a whistleblower had come out from the CDC regarding vaccines and autism.

The fact was that, you know, this, this guy who claims vaccines and autism cause autism had a retracted paper that became the story. And so I became the target. John.

Yeah, Brian, maybe it might be helpful just to go into, um, you know, their fingerprints on this because, you know, they essentially, uh, accused you of, um, uh, scientific fraud or misconduct, didn't they, in relation to this.

But, you know, from when you look at it now, you can see that, that the heavy hand of, uh, of those, uh, likely with an interest, uh, there was no balance was there to this story.

No, there was absolutely no balance to this story and it was night and day. You know, the alternative media, the media that would be friendly to, you know, questioning your doctor, questioning the medical authorities, um, were right in our camp.

They really, really understood they, you know, I, I was granted interviews, uh, but when it came to mainstream media, it was either absolute crickets. Or it was, um, you know, I became the target and I became the smear campaign, uh, knowing that 70 percent of advertising for news channels, um, is, is, uh, from the pharmaceutical industry and non election years and election years a little different, but in non election years, then it started to make sense.

And I got so close, uh, with Fox news. I got very, very close. I was talking to a wonderful reporter there by the name of John Roberts. Uh, we were talking back and forth about this story. Uh, they were able to bring the whistleblower forward to talk to reporters off the record. Uh, he couldn't talk on the record because he would have been fired from the CDC.

Uh, and he did not want to lose his job. I mean, whistleblower protection was nil. I mean, it's absolutely nil for, uh, Dr. William Thompson. And we got so close. And then, you know, one conversation, uh, with a mainstream doctor who is on the staff of Fox News, uh, between William Thompson and the whole thing ended.

It absolutely, a mainstream doctor, his name is Dr. Mark Siegel, ended the whole conversation and we could have had mainstream media coverage, but it was so frustrating to be so close. It was like there was a crack in the edifice and then it was taken away.

Boy, don't we know that, John? I mean, look at, you know, you've got Dr.

Norman Swan and Dr. Nick Coatsworth, they're the TV darlings, and to some, yeah, you know, to some extent, um, uh, you know, we've seen this happen time and time again, and yet, but we're starting to see their narrative starting to crumble, um, but still mainstream media don't Don't want to grab it. Is it because, do you think that it's because they don't want to be seen as being wrong in the first place or are they just so corrupted they just want to keep pushing it?

There have been so many times, uh, that we've gotten close. You know, I've, I've worked with, uh, Robert F. Kennedy Jr. Um, and you know, he can talk about anything in the mainstream media except for vaccines. He cannot talk about vaccines. And then all of a sudden if a word does get uttered, then they say, Oh, well, that's debunked and or it gets edited out.

But, you know, I think that there is so much corruption from on high. I mean, there were. Um, there was a reporter, I believe it was Jake Tapper, who, uh, interviewed, uh, Mr. Kennedy when he published an article called Deadly Immunity back in 2005, and, and that, uh, article appeared in the Rolling Stone and, uh, also in, uh, Salon.

Um, and when Jake Tapper interviewed Bobby Kennedy, Um, everything was on the rails. It was, I think, I believe it was going to be on CNN. Uh, but a producer from on a high squashed it and completely squashed the story. Uh, Jake Tapper had to break the news to, uh, Mr. Kennedy and said that, you know, it was one of the most disillusioning things.

Uh, in his career as a reporter that he could not report what was going on. This was specifically, you know, about mercury, uh, in vaccines and, you know, mercury is a neurotoxin. Of course, it's going to cause neurodevelopmental disabilities, uh, but CNN refused to report it. And again, You know, it was coming from on a high.

It was not coming from the reporters themselves. Uh, you know, it was either mainstream doctors that were shutting it down or corporate again and money talks. They were getting pharmaceutical advertising money.

Darling. Recently, um, there was a recording made of former president, uh, Donald Trump talking with Bobby Kennedy, uh, uh, after, uh, his assassination attempt, um, Trump's assassination attempt and, and Trump really, uh, laid into, to the vaccines.

Um, did, did you get a chance to see that?

I did see that. I saw that, and it, and it really hearkens back to, uh, 2000, uh, January, 2017, uh, when Mr. Kennedy was actually invited to Trump Towers to talk directly to then President-elect Trump about the Vaccine Safety Commission and having a vaccine safety commission.

Um, and, you know, it, it was, it was an instance where. Mr. Trump, you know, basically said, yeah, Bobby, it's okay for you to talk to reporters about this. Bobby came down from, you know, the penthouse of Trump towers. He talked to the press directly about the possibility of this vaccine safety commission, and then it vanished.

It, it was completely killed. It never, it never actually happened. It was very, very dissatisfying. It was very, very destructive. And we had heard from the through the grapevine. That was probably Bill Gates, who went to Trump afterwards and said, you do not want to do this. You know, and Bill Gates being, you know, a multi billionaire.

Um, then, uh, then influence. I don't know exactly how much influence he had with, uh, then President elect Trump, but then, you know, that never really saw the light of day. But it seems like, you know, the president in the background, uh, the former president, uh, now in the background is still holding those views.

Is still holding those views about vaccines, uh, you know, uh, when, before he was elected at the debates, president Trump was somebody that brought up too many vaccines and children. Um, and in that, in that particular debate, it was also affirmed by Dr. Ben Carson and said, yeah, you know, I believe that we need to research this and there are too many vaccines.

And so, you know, it's been, you know, there have been these sort of, uh, like I said before, cracks in the edifice. Uh, where individuals, you know, uh, running for election and then the president elect were willing to look at this. But I, you know, there's so many influences. There's so many financial influences and other insidious influences.

I believe that really take away those opportunities.

Wow. You know, we, uh, my wife and I have been doing a lot of, uh, family counseling or mentoring families on the brink of marital disaster for about 18 years. And, and in those 18 years, we've seen children play a major part in the disruption that brings about the eventual destruction of marriages because kids seem to be these days, put on a pedestal in relationships where the parents are struggling, but the kids are getting everything that they need.

But that's another story. But the one thing that we hear quite often is, Our son or our daughter is on the spectrum. And it makes life very difficult. More and more are we hearing people referring to autism in some way. Are you able to trace for us, Trace for us, The origins of autism, how, how bad it was when it was first discovered and where it's projected to go to as a result of what we're seeing now.

Have you got any data on that?

I do the origins of autism really the first patient that was identified with autism was a gentleman by the name of Donald triplet and this was back in the 1930s and Donald triplet and several other children were evaluated in a case series of reports that were done by a doctor by the name of Leo Connor.

Dr. Leo Connor was, uh, then sort of the father. of the autism diagnosis, coined the autism diagnosis. And then it was a very, very rare diagnosis. Um, incidentally, uh, Donald Triplett and these other kids that were, uh, diagnosed, uh, were also very, very close to, uh, individuals. You know, I believe that Donald Triplett's father was a chemist, uh, and brought home chemical residues.

Uh, others were Exposed to chemicals through farm environments. And so you have to look at, you know, what's the connection? Was there an iatrogenic connection even back then when autism was first being diagnosed? Uh, so the rate of autism was very, very low, uh, until about the 1980s. You know, I didn't grow up with autistic kids in school.

You know, I, I, uh, you know, uh, was born in 1963, graduated from high school in 1981. You know, that was something that. really wasn't brought to the forefront until the movie Rain Man came out in the late 1980s. Uh, but at the same time, the vaccine liability shield was erected in the United States in 1986, and then it became illegal to sue a vaccine manufacturer.

So more and more Vaccines added to the schedule, you know, by the time, uh, the 1990s, uh, to the 2000s roll around, the autism, we look around, the autism rate has gone from about one in 5, 000 to about one in 150. And, you know, so people are like, what's going on? What's happening? But it coincides so beautifully with the vaccination schedule.

With addition of vaccines to the vaccination schedule, they added the hep B, they added the haemophilus influenzae B, they added the chickenpox, they added the rotavirus, and you can go on pneumovax, uh, uh, meningococcal vax, and you can go on and on. And then the annual flu shot. And you see that. Um, the trajectory of autism is now exponentially growing at 1 in 36 children in the United States.

1 in 36, and incidentally 1 in 34 in African Americans. You know, and, and to me, you know, that, that shows, you know, and that needs more investigation because of the revelation of the CDC whistleblower and that, that increased risk for African American boys, um, and it is exponential growth where are at the exponential curve and, uh, a researcher by the name of Dr.

Stephanie Seneff at Massachusetts, uh, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, MIT, uh, Um, says that, you know, if this trajectory continues, then by 19, I'm sorry, by 2032, the rate of autism will be one in two children, and it will affect about 80 percent of all males. Uh, so we're headed for a disaster. We're headed for a catastrophe and yet more and more vaccines get added to the schedule every day, especially with the advent of covert 19 and now they've approved the R.

S. V. vaccine in pregnancy and also an R. S. V. monoclonal antibody therapy. That's killing babies. That is given, you know, very, very soon after birth.

My God. I mean. I, I am, I am speechless. Look, John and I attended. On the 30th anniversary of the AVN, the Australian Vaccination Risk Network, with Meryl Dory, Anita Huffmeister, and the crew there, it was an amazing event.

And it opened our eyes, John, because we heard a lot of people step up to the stage and tell their story. And their stories of dealing with the vaccine injured for the last 30 years, but not only that, but The vilification they've faced at the hands of the mainstream media and, and people who go along with that narrative, uh, it was shocking.

And, and we both made a pledge to them then that we were going to keep highlighting this issue because, you know, Rome's burning and nobody's doing anything about it. I mean, it's just bizarre.

Absolutely. You know, there's so much going on and there's such a high level of persecution. My, uh, you know, my, I have my deepest gratitude for people like Meryl Dory, uh, Tasha David, um, uh, Nita, uh, I forget how do you say your last name?

Meister, um, uh, Nita was not involved in the, in the VAX tour when we went down under, but, uh, Marilyn, Tasha, uh, were such gracious hosts and they've done so much, you know, with the threat of like jail time for the, you know, for the AVN, uh, they've endured so much persecution. Uh, by, you know, the mainstream press in social media, they've been absolutely eviscerated.

But, you know, they, they've done so much the avian, uh, you know, to me. Uh, was the saving grace of, of the, uh, of Australia from, you know, all of these vaccine mandates and, uh, you know, now they, you know, I, I was, I was praying that they continued and they continued to thrive with all of the persecution that went on through the COVID pandemic.

Um, it is, you know, my, my hat is off to them. They're, they, they're really along with, with both of you, you're doing God's work.

Well, you know, we, we thank God for that, of course. And, and um, at, at the end of the day, you can't ignore the unignorable. I mean, the, the reason, look, a lot of, all we're saying, we're not, John and I aren't medical experts.

John is to some degree being a paramedic. He's done a lot of training and his wife's a nurse of 25 years as well. I've got a nurse of uh, 50 odd years, uh, married to me. But the thing is at the end of the day, when I made my decision not to get vaccinated. Two days before I had booked in to get it, I might add, because I did my research.

All I'm saying to people is, do your research. Please do your research. Don't accept blindly what's been told to you. Now a lot of you are defending like crazy the vaccine schedule for children and the, the COVID vaccine rollout policy and all that. You're defending it like crazy, but not based on any knowledge of it.

You're just accepting what's been given to you, what you read in the paper, what you see in the news. And a friend of mine from Oklahoma said that I was flying with him years ago. He was a captain when I was a co pilot. Uh, I told him once that there was a new procedure out that we'd received a memo over, and he thought it was a crazy procedure and so did I.

And I said to him, well, we've got to follow it, haven't we? He said, well, you don't all want to believe what you read on a piece of paper, just lay down flat and let any sucker rat on it. And that's true in this situation we're in. If you don't do your research, then you've got to bear the responsibility of that later on.

Is that, is that how you want your children to go through life? Carrying hardships, physical, mental, emotional, because you couldn't be bothered doing your research because you were too busy castigating people who did? I mean, that's what it boils down to, is it not?

It really is. You know, I, I couldn't agree more.

Um, we are told by the experts that they're the experts and there's some special protected class, you know, during the pandemic in the United States, Tony Fauci says, well, I am the science when you attack me, you attack the science. I mean, what a nutcase. That is absolutely crazy. I mean, you know, you talk about ego maniac, maniac, malag, uh, uh, magallo maniac, you know, every maniac on the sun, under the sun, and first of all, or second of all, that's a very unscientific statement.

How can you make that particular statement and trust the science again, you know, rails against like nails and a chalkboard to me, um, because you don't trust science, you test science, you test it, you, you look at the information, you look at the data, you look at the outcomes and you evaluate that and we're told as a society that we're too dumb to do it, uh, absolutely, you know, rubbish.

Absolute rubbish. And so, uh, Mr. Kennedy and I, um, started doing research in 2019 that ended up in a book that was published in 2023 called Vaxxed on Vaxxed, Let the Science Speak. And, you know, in this, we laid out the science when you compare vaccinated children, vaccinated adults, To unvaccinated children, unvaccinated adults.

We didn't think we would find any studies. We found over 100 studies that did that very thing. And then we highlighted those studies in that book because we wanted to bring, uh, the science to the masses. We wanted to be for science to be able to be digested by parents, by practitioners, by individuals making their own vaccine decisions.

I don't think anybody should be sidelined from doing that. Their research, we do not trust the experts. The experts have let us down. And if anything, we can safely say, do not trust the government to tell you to put anything into your body.

Wow, Johnny. Oh, well, I think that's a great segue. I mean, the reality is first do no harm.

I mean, that's the first premise first do no harm. I mean, we don't know that what the injecting isn't causing further harm somewhere else. I mean, clearly we don't know that. Uh, well, in some cases we do and it keeps getting cancelled out. I mean, it seems ridiculous to me that, you know, in any other, in any other timeframe, Brian, I mean, you could be the head of any operation for any country in the world in some back corner.

Making things that would, you know, kill people by the millions. Uh, I mean, your resume would, would be frightening. Um, I mean, you clearly know what you're doing. Um, uh, it seems to me that, uh, we can't just go along trusting these organizations, these peer reviewed journals, these, you know, these organizations that, uh, push all this stuff.

I mean, Similar situation to what's happened to this Dr. Andrew Wakefield. I mean, he's another one, uh, that appears to have, uh, been vilified. I mean, this guy was a transplant, uh, surgeon in London, uh, but deregistered because he dared to speak up about, uh, vaccines. Um, you know, the whole thing is a smoking gun to me.

Uh, and that's why we need to really look at it. I mean, if nothing else, I mean, I'm. Sure, there could be other causes to, to, uh, or contributors to, to, to outcomes. But, uh, unless we look at them and analyze them and, and don't disrespect people like Brian, uh, for actually doing the work, uh, and coming up with, uh, you know, some reasonable explanations as to what's happening and then cancel it out because somebody else, you know, Claims to be a better expert than him.

I mean, it's madness.

I, I couldn't agree more. You know, I, uh, I'm good friends with, uh, Dr. Wayfield. He, um, you know, went out on a limb on 1998, the paper that he published in the journal, The Lancet, uh, merely suggested that there could be a relationship between the MMR vaccine and the timing of autistic regression.

Uh, and he did a case series, and he reported that out of the 12 autistic children that he, he looked at, uh, you know, uh, gut tissue, uh, biopsies, uh, results of different testing, uh, in these autistic children identified a new syndrome in, in, you know, that it was groundbreaking research, but by the mere suggestion that out of those 12 patients, eight of the parents reported regression after the MMR vaccine, you know, basically made him a target for life.

Absolutely, you know, he was struck off from the, you know, General Medical Council in 2011, uh, can no longer practice medicine in, in the UK, or really, for all intents and purposes, anywhere else, but he's still spreading the word. Uh, uncovered, you know, the fraud of, uh, that was brought to, uh, forward by two other whistleblowers at Merck regarding, you know, the mumps efficacy and the mumps, uh, virus concentration in the MMR vaccine.

He's got a new movie called Protocol 7 that very, very beautifully tells that story. And he's still getting the word out. I mean, you know, my hats off to somebody like that. He lost his career. He lost his family. He lost his country. And yet he's still, you know, like the Energizer bunny. He's still just going forward and he's spreading the word.

This is, this is what astounds me. So many credible scientists and doctors.

Yes.

Who had just canceled in, you know, and censored into oblivion because they're disagreeing with the narrative, which is you can't have science and censorship together, can you? You said that you

can't, you cannot have science and censorship and it goes, you know, it happens all the time.

It, you know, getting canceled, uh, getting censored and social media, uh, the inability to publish papers in mainstream medical journals, you know, I scratched my head, you know, to get something that might raise a question regarding a vaccine published. In a journal that's indexed by the U. S. National Library of Medicine, uh, you know, my, my colleagues and I at Children's Health Defense will get, will get rejected seven or eight times without them even reading the paper.

All they do is read the names. They're like, oh, Brian Hooker's an anti vaxxer, you can't publish here. And I've, and I've had that, I've had that exact statement from journals who have said, no, you cannot publish in our journal.

Isn't it amazing, Brian, you can't publish, uh, with your background, but somebody like Professor Robert Boye here in Australia, who, uh, it's alleged, uh, is receiving, uh, payments from, uh, Merck, from Pfizer.

Uh, is just a mouthpiece, uh, as it would seem for the, uh, for the pharmaceutical companies. I mean, uh, they're happy to investigate you and knock down all your research, but somebody like this without any real skin in the game can come in and, and basically alter the way Alter the, uh, the opinions and, uh, understanding and, um, and, and rationale, uh, in people's minds in, in, in places like Australia on, on mainstream television, uh, and, uh, not, you know, accountable to anyone, uh, above them, they can just do whatever they like.

Um, they don't even have to divulge who they're receiving money from.

That's criminal. That is absolutely criminal. That's a criminal conflict of interest. And, you know, that type of bias, um, you know, everybody brings some type of bias to the table. When I write a paper, I fully disclose that I have a child with autism.

That I believe sustained a vaccine injury. I think that that's full disclosure and people should know my perspective. People should also know that if I get, you know, that I get a million dollar grant or a 10 million grant from Pfizer, you know, obviously that is going to, you know, shade your judgment. If I, if you know, if the paycheck that comes to that supports you and your family comes from Pfizer, everybody should know.

Everybody should know those conflicts of interest and, you know, does it disqualify them from publishing science? Well, maybe, you know, but we need to know. We need to know that individual's perspective, that individual's background. Um, you know, I've seen research funded, uh, that, that lauded Johnson Johnson's products, and then you look at the very, very end of the research, that particular research was funded by Johnson Johnson.

You know, we see this in the open literature all the time, and when they censor that information, when we do not know what those individuals conflicts of interest are, then, you know, like I said, I believe it's criminal because it's so, so deceptive.

We, we had a case recently with Julian Gillespie, who I'm sure you know, uh, here in Australia who fought, uh, in the courts on the, uh, unlicensed GMO, which was, uh, Pfizer and, and the, uh, mRNA vaccines, having discovered that, uh, it is a genetically modified organism and it was being administered without a license.

The case was solid, but it was thrown out by a judge who didn't admit at the time that she was legal counsel for Pfizer for decades. Thank you very much. Before she became a judge. I mean, and now, she's under scrutiny, and rightfully so. And, um, and her tenure is obviously, uh, under great, under a great shadow as it should be.

She shouldn't have even been adjudicating on the case, but she didn't declare her conflict of interest with the loyalties she had to Pfizer.

Exactly. Exactly. And that goes on and on and on and on. And I think that for, you know, the whole debacle that was COVID. Uh, and so many people injured in such, you know, really dastardly ways.

I mean, we're looking at the uptick in turbo cancers, these cancers that are growing so rapidly after receiving the Pfizer vaccine or after receiving the, uh, the Moderna vaccine. You know, we really need a Nuremberg 2.0. You know, this, this whole thing, uh, you know, and we have individuals in the United States, like even, uh, Tony Fauci and his boss at the National Institutes of Health at the time, Francis Collins, now calling for amnesty, you know, calling for, oh, well, we were just doing the best that we could do with that decision.

Well, you know, Tony Fauci's best was to earn about 6 million. Over the pandemic, when you look at his net worth prior to the pandemic, it was between five and 6 million. Now it's about 14 million. So don't tell me he was doing the best for us. He was doing the best for him.

Absolutely, man. I mean, now in Australia, Johnny, you might know the numbers off the top of your head.

Um, I think when I was a kid, we got five vaccinations. Um, right now I think a child, uh, is it up to the age of 14 has 48 vaccinations. I think that's wrong. It's something like that. What, what's the right in, in the states if you have that data? Um, uh, I

know for up to age 18, it is, uh, anywhere from 53 to 57 actual needle sticks and some of those are multivalent vaccines like MMR or, or diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis.

Um, so, so, yeah, it is, um, it's absolutely outrageous because they haven't tested these vaccines together. They have not tested the cumulative effect of the vaccination schedule, you know, individuals like myself, uh, you know, my colleague, Neil Miller, uh, Uh, James Lyons Weiler, uh, uh, Anthony Mawson, um, Dr. Paul Thomas, you know, we're doing the research.

We're looking at these things and the outcomes are not good for children that are receiving so many vaccines, you know, that have never been tested. In the United States at your sex, at their six month, you know, quote unquote, well baby checkup, you could get eight needle jabs. You could get eight.

different needle jabs in that single visit. You know, we ran out of limbs a long time ago. So, you know, where do they put the extra four? Um, and again, they have never been tested together.

And is it true, Brian, that the Japanese, uh, don't, don't give the vaccines all at once? So the MMR is actually broken up.

Are you aware? I'm

not sure about their, their broken up. They do get less vaccines in, uh, in Japan, uh, significantly less vaccines. And I believe that most vaccines are delayed until after age two. Um, and so they do have a lower rate of autism. Um, they also, uh, recognize the problems with the human papillomavirus vaccine, the HPV vaccine.

Uh, that is no longer, uh, required. Uh for teenagers in japan, I believe, you know, somebody told me it was banned. I don't think that's true I think you can still get it Uh, but it at least they took it down as a requirement because they did Do their research the government did the research they found a lot of adverse events Uh, especially in japanese girls from the hpv vaccine and and they did the right thing, you know, uh, it's it's That's a good example

That's the Gardasil for those out there.

That's

correct. Yes. I'm sorry. Go ahead. Yeah,

I don't know that. Um, so, I mean, I mean, here we go. Look, there's a perfect example. I mean, you would obviously know what the stats are out of Japan. I mean, so why doesn't, uh, why don't we have a review of places where they're doing it differently? Just to start with, I mean, there's a perfect example.

Exactly, exactly. And some people have done this. One of my colleagues, Neil Miller, looked at the first year mortality rates in countries, in developed countries, and the vaccination rate. And the first year mortality was actually higher. In those countries that vaccinated more and vaccinated more aggressively, especially, uh, in the

first year of life, you know, in the United States, children in the first year of life, get upwards to 28 different needle jobs, 28 different needle sticks, you know, by their, by their first birthday.

And yet we have one of the highest infant mortality rates, if not the highest in the developed world. I mean, we need to start asking, we need to start asking these questions and we need to do comparisons with countries that vaccinate less, as well as doing comparisons, you know, one of the things that they're trying to do in the United States is get rid of the unvaccinated control group, you know, because they're so healthy.

They're so much healthier. My research has shown they get less asthma, they get less allergies, they get less ear infections, less autism, less ADD, ADHD, you know, uh, Nian to, you know, the, the health of these children, uh, astounds me, you know, some of them don't even get an ear infection and, you know, I remember my son's childhood, he was really a walking ear infection just from the vaccines that he got up to 15 months of age.

Well, I'm sure if you asked anyone at Pfizer or Moderna or any of these other, uh, manufacturing plants, how many vaccines you were required to have before the age of two in America, it wouldn't be 28. It'd be a dollar figure. That's how they'd equate it. It would be whatever money, uh, raised is.

It's, it's absolutely, people don't know how much money vaccines make.

You know, I've actually heard the comment in a statement from the, you know, the pro vaccine astroturbers. Oh, well, they lose money on vaccines. Not true. Not true. Look at, look at what happened with Pfizer. Look at what happened with Moderna, their combined sales for the COVID 19 vaccine easily eclipsed 100 billion, 100 billion over the pandemic.

I mean, they were reporting these types of numbers, you know, in 2022. Okay. So we don't know what the sales were even after that. Um, you know, the thing that scares me is they're looking for the next opportunity to make that type of money. And so, you know, there are other mRNA vaccines that are being tested.

There's an mRNA vaccine for RSV that is now being marketed. There's a self replicating mRNA vaccine. Uh, I believe for COVID that is being marketed in Japan right now. Um, and, you know, so they're looking for this profit void that, you know, happened after people stopped getting their COVID shots.

Unbelievable. I was interviewed on TNT radio yesterday morning by Dean Makin. And, um, it was, it was an expose on what's going on at Boeing. Now, Boeing is one of the largest corporations in America. And they had a, they had a magnificent record for superb engineering. They build a wonderful airplane. And I live by the motto as many airline pilots did of that age, that if it ain't Boeing, I ain't going.

Um, it was such a good product. Now they have just copped a guilty play. So that they don't have to go through years of court battles. Embarrassing court battles where they're, they're laid open like a filleted fish on a table. Uh, so they cop the guilty plea and they'll pay out damages to the families of, I think, 386 people who were killed because Boeing installed a secret, uh, maneuvering capability, uh, augmentation system, MCAS, into an airplane because it was inherently unstable and they didn't tell the purchaser or the pilots who flew them.

So as a result of the malfunction of that system, nobody knew how to get out of that problem. There was no procedure written for it. And two aircraft nosedived into the ground with a full load of people on board. Now Boeing, Boeing has gone from the prestigious corporate aircraft builder of the world to a second rate player.

And that was allowed to happen because the FAA, the governing body, Didn't do its job. They played cozy with Boeing. Boeing doesn't have immunity from prosecution. Pfizer and Moderna and the pharmaceutical companies do. This is what's really concerning. And the, the TGA and, and the, um, the, the TGA in Australia, uh, the worst at being funded by big pharma, we're told that 95 percent of all the funding to the TGA comes from big pharmaceutical companies.

That's the fox managing the hen house. So exactly. There is going to come a time. And I think you, you will see an up. I'm sure you're seeing an increase in people who are supporting the research that you're coming out with now from experience. They're starting to say, hang on. These guys were right all along.

There's going to come a time when somebody will be held to account. It will happen. It's going to happen. I'm touring New Zealand in September with Professor Angus Dalglish from St. George's Teaching Hospital in London. He's one of the world's leading oncologists. He's saying that turbo cancers are a result of mRNA vaccinations, inoculations, and that they are going through the roof.

We are speaking at stadiums. We're not speaking in church halls. We're speaking, we're speaking in booked out stadiums in New Zealand. People are waking up. Are you finding that in the states as well?

Absolutely. Um, you know, if you look, I saw one statistic at the number of parents or the percentage of parents questioning the childhood vaccination schedule in the United States has gone up, you know, pre pandemic levels, about 4 percent that were questioning the vaccination schedule.

Uh, now it's anywhere between 20 and 30 percent of those parents are reevaluating whether they are going to vaccinate their Children. And so, you know, that that to me is is life saved. That is, uh, you know, individuals that were are prevented. Uh, a lifetime of, uh, disability that, um, they, they could, that could be foisted on.

I mean, you know, look at my own family, uh, and the hardships that we have had to face. Um, and more and more people are, are coming out of the woodwork. They're asking questions of the government. More and more people know how much money, and they see, you know, directly how much money is, is absolutely being made.

And, you know, and I think. Uh, not only from, you know, a population statistics standpoint, uh, but the, the level of interest in organizations like Children's Health Defense, the High Wire, uh, the National Vaccine Information Center in the United States that have, you know, that have been around that do really, really good work, um, is, is increased, you know, significantly over the timing of the pandemic.

You know, we, we've seen the government captured by the pharmaceutical industry, um, you know, the FDA, the CDC, the National Institutes of Health are all in the pocket of the pharmaceutical industry, and, and that is now, you know, the, these large dollar signs and, and these conflicts of interest are now being exposed in a big way.

And, you know, I, I couldn't be happier about that.

Yeah, we're definitely seeing it, John, aren't we? I mean, we've gone through the, we had rallies in our national capital, hundreds of thousands of people turned up from all over Australia. It was the biggest rally in Australian history. And they're all there for various reasons, but at the core of it all was the fact that the government overcooked the goose and mandated people.

And they've come to realize that if the government is bribing, coercing or bullying you to do something, it's obviously not in your best interest. And people are waking up now to that fact. So we can look forward to a future. I'm sure we're more and more people will wake up and just ask the question.

That's all you have to do. You don't have to grab a gun. You don't have to make Molotov cocktails. Just ask a question and be prepared to say no. If you disagree, if it's not in your best interest, you're the one responsible for your best interest, not the government. Johnny.

Such a powerful word. Just, just go to your practitioner, go to that individual in that white coat and say, you know, no, I'm good.

I'm good. I don't, you know, I don't need my COVID shot. I don't need my flu shot. Um, you know, some people struggle with that. I mean, doctors have been such an authority figure for so many years. You know, you just

want to listen to your doctor, uh, talk to your doctor, trust your doctor. Uh, no, these individuals are being financially incentivized to get you vaccinated.

Well, sadly, if you listen to your doctor nowadays, Johnny, you're listening to Bill Gates, aren't you?

Right. Well, that's the unfortunate part about it, and I, and I suppose, you know, there's still so many people out there that are concerned about where this mRNA technology has put them. Um, you know, you've obviously got a long standing history in, in, uh, in, in Chemistry and designing all this stuff, Brian.

I mean, what, what's your take on, on, on reversing the situation? Is it plausible?

The reversing the damage regarding mRNA vaccines is very, very difficult. It's more of a difficult and daunting task, um, because. your genetic code gets reprogrammed. You know, this is, it's, it's not, it's not as if there's a toxin that you can just walk, uh, wash away from your cells, but instead, um, you know, the reprogramming that goes on and, and we're, we're working at Children's Health Defense right now on a project to confirm whether, you know, the genetic code does end up in your body.

in your own genome, especially in turbo cancers. So we're looking at turbo cancers and looking for the spike protein code to see if it's integrated into the chromosomes. Uh, but they're finding that, uh, people become perpetual spike protein production factories. You know, some, uh, studies show that an individual gets vaccine.

They're still producing spike protein in their system, uh, 245 days later. You know, and we were told by the pharmaceutical industry that the spike protein would express in your upper arm, in your upper deltoid muscle for two weeks, you know, so 14 days is way different than 245 days. Uh, but you know, I trust innovation.

I've met so many wonderful practitioners over the COVID 19 era that want to put this right. And they are putting this right. We have, uh, the frontline, uh, COVID critical care, uh, alliance in the United States, uh, that is looking at, you know, what they call long COVID vaccine injury, and it's a syndrome. It looks very, very much like chronic fatigue, uh, uh, um, Uh, very, you know, much involving, uh, the, uh, neurodegeneration nervous system and trying to put that, you know, type of injury right.

I, you know, I can't tell you how many stories I've heard of individuals that, you know, used to be long distance runners that can't get out of bed. You know, because they received the COVID vaccine and that along with cardiac damage, you know, seems to be some of the biggest issue, issues that people are facing when they get a COVID vaccine injury.

And do you think shedding is an issue with, with, with what we're saying?

Absolutely. Uh, you know, I've heard too many anecdotal reports of, of shedding. Uh, we were involved in a project, uh, with women who were surveyed, who never received a vaccine, who never got COVID, but lived in the proximity of somebody who was vaccinated.

And, and I'll tell you, there's a statistically significant difference and menstrual issues. And other problems regarding female anatomy in the women who were within six feet of somebody who received the COVID vaccine, you know, on a daily basis on a, you know, uh, so somebody that lived with them, work with them.

And then we had a control group that never received the vaccine, never had COVID, but we're not exposed to that, you know, sort of shedding phenomenon. Uh, and there was, there was a really, really strong market significant difference. Um, and there has also been research in the biochemistry, uh, showing that, uh, the MRNA can persist in breast milk of, uh, women who have been vaccinated who are nursing, uh, you know, and, and they found it, you know, 24, 48 hours, that actual genetic code, then going to the newborn or the baby that was nursing.

Um, and so you see shedding phenomenon like that and there are reports of Children, uh, you know, nursing moms who got vaccinated and then their child died within like two or three days.

Oh, for goodness sake. I mean, what could possibly go wrong, Johnny, but, uh, I've got to, we've got to let you go. I know, Brian, because you're very, very busy, man, but I want to ask you one last question from me.

Yes, sir.

Do you think that long COVID is the camouflage net that they're throwing over vaccine injury?

Absolutely. Absolutely. I, I see so many people that, that have, you know, sort of this long COVID syndrome and so many of them are vaccinated, you know, about 70 percent of the population of the United States received at least one COVID shot.

Um, you know, men, women, women. Um, adults, elderly children, 70%. So you know, we've basically conducted a society wide experiment and, and now they mask it as long COVID and, and I can't tell you how many healthcare professionals have, you know, when they, when they realize who I am and, and, you know, with the research that I've done, how many health professionals will tell me privately, yeah, this is long COVID is because the vaccine.

Wow. Charlie. Yeah. Brian, one last quick one, uh, blood products, uh, in the Yes. In America, uh, the Red Cross, uh, a ask you to identify whether you, whether you've had an mRNA vaccine, uh, they don't do that in Australia. I mean, what's, what's the reason they're, they're targeting, um, people wanting to know, um, and, and do you think we need separate blood banks for the unvaccinated?

I do believe that we need separate blood banks for the unvaccinated or worry about that. I worry about that in, in the case of hospital transfusions, because many hospitals are refusing to, you know, honor the request of individuals to get unvaccinated blood and you can, you know, you can find blood banks that do have unvaccinated blood that you can get, but you have to go through a, you know, kind of a, a, a Uh, circuitous network in order to get those products, but the messenger RNA is modified.

It is modified messenger RNA to be rock solid stable in cells and in blood cells. And so it's very, very feasible that you could get a transfusion and then all of a sudden you get MRNA that's creating spike protein in your body at a very, very high level. I mean, you know, when you do a transfusion, it's a lot of material.

And so, yes, absolutely.

Well, look, you know, we've got it. We've got to bring it to a halt. I'll close it with a prayer in a moment. Bill Gates has admitted on mainstream media that the best investment he ever made was COVID vaccination. He increased his profit by 20 times, 20 times. Um, I mean, that's just, it's unforgivable what's happening.

It really is. And the more and more we talk to people like you, uh, the more we realize just how crazy this is. And, um, and we've just got to keep plugging at it. We can't, people are saying COVID We can't because there's going to be avian bird flu that's happening in Australia at the moment. We're seeing that, uh, you know, right across the globe, you know, we're going to be shooting at, we're going to be shooting at pigeons soon because they're going to be deadly carriers of disease.

There's so much. Scrutiny that we have to apply and we've got to keep this pressure on. So I'm proud to say that I'm now an anti vaxxer. What about you, John? A

hundred percent. Uh, I mean, unless they come up with something, uh, that is, is, uh, going to sway me. Otherwise, I mean, the information, uh, that I've received from credible people, uh, no nonsense with, with backed up data is, is ironclad.

You know, you can't argue with

it. And I want to thank Scott Morrison and the Australian government and Big Pharma and the corporates who turned me into an anti vaxxer. Thank you for saving my life. You overcooked the goose, you pushed it too far and you got a whole bunch of normal people like us who woke up and we appreciate being woken up.

But I want you to know that you woke us up. You wake us up because you went too hot.

I, I so appreciate the encouragement. I, uh, you know, I, I've been a closeted anti vaxxer for many, many years and avoided using that term, but I, I am an anti vaxxer. There's no way around it.

There is no way around it. And, um, let's, let's close this with a prayer.

I would ask you once we stop recording, Brian, if you just stay on for 30 seconds, I just need to ask you something, but let's, uh, let's bring, uh, Jesus into this and close it with a prayer.

Amen.

Lord, father in heaven, we thank you for the courage that is demonstrated by thousands of people around the world, hundreds of thousands of people around the world, perhaps millions of people around the world, but we uphold Dr.

Brian Hooker to your father today because he has stood. In the face of adversity for telling the truth for a long, long time. He has a good reason to stand. He has seen the effects of these man made substances that are interfering with your designed immune system that you gave us, which works beautifully.

We thank you father for those who are prepared to risk everything to stand in their truth. Because all we need to do is analyze and do our research, Father God, and we ask you to guide us through that process. Lord, we pray that more and more people will start asking questions. That's all we ask, Father God, and we pray that you will provide a mechanism for their answers.

In Jesus name, Amen. Amen. Johnny, you've often been heard to say You just couldn't make this stuff up. You couldn't make this stuff up. Stay out of the trees, everybody. Don't forget, if you love somebody and you haven't told them, ring them and tell them, give them a call. You may just save their life. It's a crazy world, but what you did yesterday got you to today.

Just keep doing it, doing your research. Dr. Brian Hooker, it's been an absolute honor to talk to you. I hope we can do it again.

Absolutely. You call me anytime, Grant or John, uh, please, please, uh, you know, and, and thank you so much for being such good brothers.

Yeah, well, it's a real pleasure and we love being in the trench with you.

We feel honored and indeed privileged to do that. So, uh, we'd ask you just to stay on for a second, but for all of you at home watching Club Grubbery tonight, please share this. It doesn't help if we don't share it. I know we get censored and shadow banned and all of that, but we've got to keep leaking this truth out there as best we can.

God bless you all. Australia is a beautiful country because you live in it. God bless you. And we'll talk to you next time on Club Grubbery. Bye
