I am contacting you regarding the Covid-19 vaccine mandates for children in Brazil.

There is now an overwhelming amount of data being presented by highly trained and skilled scientists, who are highlighting the extraordinary number of safety or danger signals of these injections.

The Brazilian government can no longer justify inaction or claim plausible deniability.

I strongly recommend you do a thorough risk benefit analysis of these mandates, to base your decisions on sound evidence, comprehensive long-term data, and the voices of the families affected.

It is unethical to base any policy making from the influence of pharmaceutical companies, who stand to profit from the widespread use of their products, or any potential financial gain. The studies analysed must show the full picture without bias to create a policy around children.

Enforcing these injections on the babies children and pregnant women, is impacting the future generation.

These mandates must be halted immediately, and now the international community is watching.
